INTRODUCTION TO LIVERPOOL FOOTBALL CLUB (LFC)

Liverpool Football Club is recognised around the world as one of an elite group of clubs with a truly worldwide reputation.

We have a very special philosophy which is well known by our players, staff and fans. This philosophy of 'the Liverpool way' allows our campers access to a leading coaching programme and experience the same coaching sessions that are delivered at the LFC Academy, ensuring campers develop and reach their full potential.

Over the two weeks the coaches will cover the follow areas:

TECHNICAL

Sessions that allow the players opportunity to practice specific techniques/skills and repetition of that technique/skill, e.g. dribbling, passing, turning, forward moves, receiving and shooting etc.

TACTICAL

Sessions that allow specific decision making opportunities and the ability to adapt and combat different pressures and systems of play with and without the ball.

PHYSICAL

Sessions encouraging players to carry out fundamental movements as well as more game related movements.

SOCIAL

Sessions to encourage players to interact with each other, problem solve, compete and work as a team.

MENTAL

Preparation, brave with and without the ball, accepting pressure, freedom of expression, positive body language are all aspects considered in this area.



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LFC COACHES

All coaches work within the LFC International Academy team and are UEFA and FA qualified.

Dave Kirner, below, was one such coach that delivered the LFC coaching sessions during the 2016 Summer Camps. Dave's qualifications include the UEFA B license and FA youth modules, as well as having worked as a Head Coach of the LFC Soccer Schools.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY ENGLISH PROGRAMME

Our English language programme helps students to improve their English language and vocabulary skills through themed, interactive exercises.

The programme allows students to easily build and apply new vocabulary skills in a sporting environment. They will become completely immersed in the language, increasing their ability to converse with confidence on and off the pitch.

The two week camp includes:

- 30 hours of classroom English instruction
- Highly qualified CELTA or TESOL teachers
- Social and interactive learning environment
- Groups based on age and English ability (where possible)
- Average class size: 15 students
- Certificate of completion

Example Class Activities

- Match day analysis allows students to improve their listening and vocabulary skills in an interactive, fun way
- Player position tasks allow students to work in a team, whilst improving their everyday English conversational skills
- Scripted interview scenarios allow students to build confidence and pronunciation skills
- Students will improve their academic writing through player performance report tasks
- Manager instruction exercises will help students gain leadership skills
- Interactive, team-building activities such as in-class player exercises and puzzles



PLAYER DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY SPORTS LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

The Sports Leadership Programme gives students valuable experience in a range of communication skills, leadership skills, public speaking and team building.

By combining football-related workshops, seminars, and interactive lessons, students will learn vital skills like researching, formal presentations, and negotiation – all of which will be useful as they grow older.

Using football and innovative learning methods, this programme inspires students who aspire to be future leaders, in football or elsewhere.

The two week camp includes:

- 30 hours of sports leadership tuition
- Highly qualified staff
- Groups based on age and English ability (where possible)
- Average class size: 15 students
- All teachers are experienced in instructing sports or business-related programmes
- Certificate of completion



Example Class Activities:

- Planning, budgeting, organisational and research based activities
- Exploration of real finance mechanisms used at global football clubs and businesses
- Manager-versus-player role play scenarios allow students to discover their own leadership style, whilst building their confidence
- Entrepreneurial tasks allow students to understand the role of an owner and how to create a football club
- Our transfer windows simulation exercise allows students to acquire the art of negotiation
- Playing strategies and tactics will be covered through interactive tasks

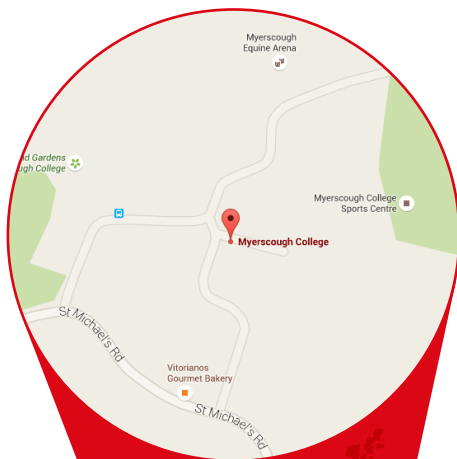

THE VENUE

Myerscough College dates back to the 19th century, when it was known as Lancashire College of Agriculture. Located in rural Lancashire, it boasts wonderful sports facilities, and is a safe haven for students to fully immerse themselves in their activities.



LOCATION

Myerscough College is easily accessible from two airports and a railway station. It is:

- 1 hour from Manchester Airport
- 1 hour from Liverpool Airport
- 30 minute drive from Preston Rail Station

Travel and Logistics

All transfers and airport pick-ups can be arranged by us. We pick up students in a minibus, with staff waiting at the airports and train station to collect students. We will also escort students back to their departure points and ensure that they board safely.

Upon arrival, we will check in all students and make sure their passports, pocket money, and travel tickets are kept in a safe place. They will also have the opportunity to call home.

If you wish to bring your child to the camp or collect them, we can provide directions upon request.

Accommodation

The college offers a comfortable and relaxing environment, with twin bedrooms so that students can get to know each other, and space for all of their belongings.

Facilities

- Twin shared bedrooms
- Separate corridors for boys and girls
- Individual storage for each child
- Shared shower and bathroom facilities



Students will benefit from access to:

- Common room with TV, table tennis and games console
- Football pitches, grass and astroturf
- 9-hole golf course
- Extreme Frisbee course
- Indoor sports hall
- Quiet room and library
- Free WIFI
- On-site shop stocked with food, toiletries and other convenient items
- Laundry facilities (for a small charge)

Meals

The college offers a varied and healthy range of meals for students, with plenty of options to choose from each day.

We cater for all dietary requirements and preferences (including vegetarian, halal, and kosher) – just let us know at the application stage.

Staff

Our staff live on-site for the duration of the programme, so if there are any issues they will be able to assist immediately.

All of our staff are medically trained and able to assist with emergencies. Full safety briefings are provided in the TLG Student Handbook. They are also DBS checked, which ensures they are completely suitable for working with children.

We have male and female staff, so all children feel comfortable and have someone they can turn to. They will also facilitate any calls home if children are homesick.

Safety

The campus is a closed environment, with on-site security monitoring 24/7 and signage for meeting points in case of an emergency.

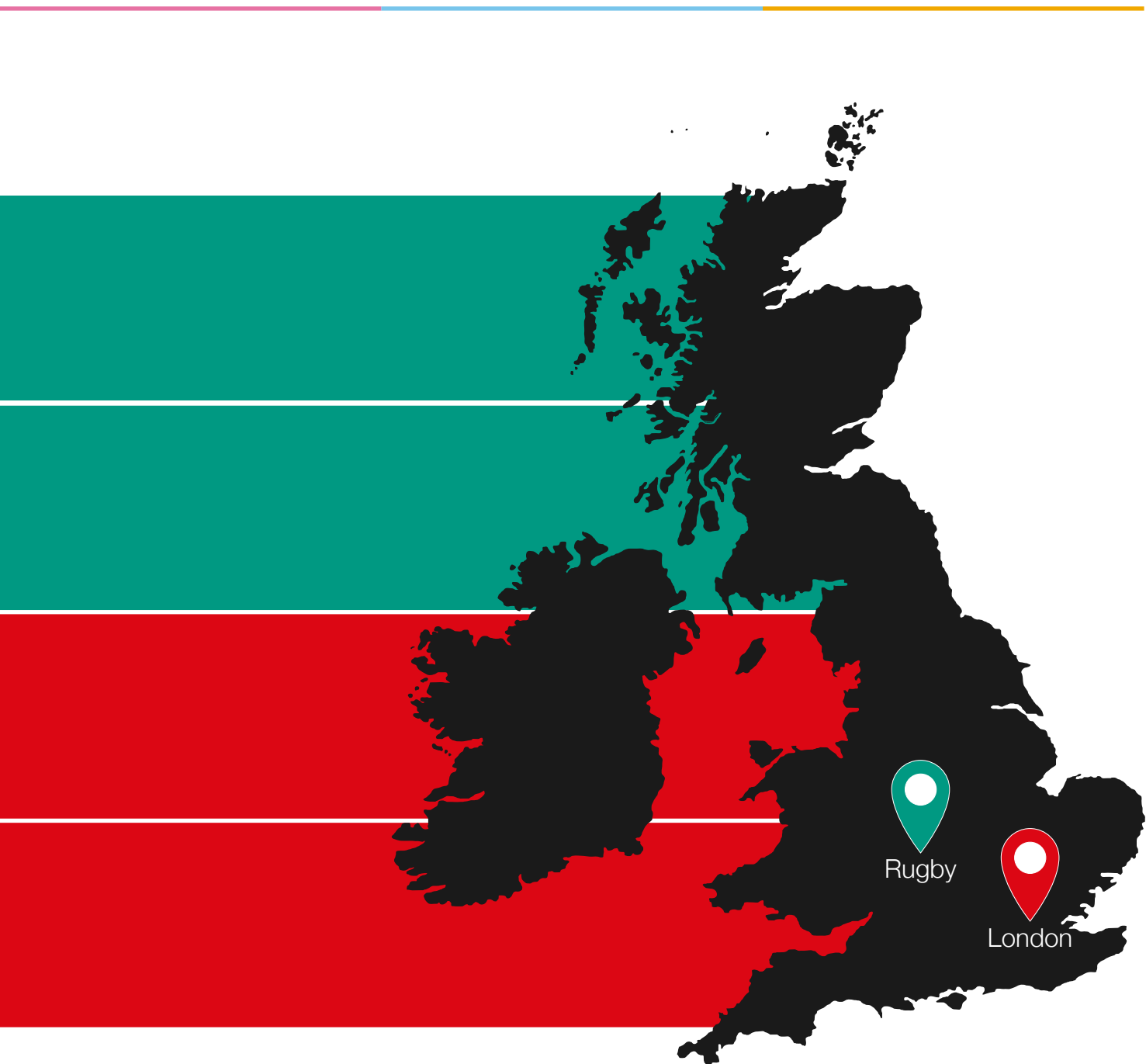
